Wheat Profitability

It is time for herbicide and topdress treatments on your wheat. Applying a herbicide to wheat is a good value even if you don't have a mustard problem. A pre-joint application can prevent summer annuals and delay your first after-harvest operation.

Fungicides on Wheat

In a recent survey of our customers, we found that most of the farmers who used a fungicide on their wheat last year were pleased with the results. We think that fungicides such as *Bumper*, *Headline*, *TwinLine*, and *Quilt* will be a growing market on wheat. An interesting new entry is *Tebuzol*, which promises very attractive pricing.

Target fields are those which are irrigated, have higher yield potential, and greater disease susceptibility. Treatment should be properly timed for flag leaf emergence. Most wheat fungicides have a 40-45 day pre-harvest interval.

Restricted Entry Intervals

Pesticides have an REI (Restricted Entry Interval) associated with them, which means that access to the field is limited after the pesticide application.

The REI varies by product, and early entry exemptions exist for emergencies, crop consultants, and owners. We are enclosing an updated summary sheet of the products which we apply.
