Use Recommendations

Here's how it works:

You can apply Ally® Extra to your wheat and barley as early as the crop's 2-leaf stage until just before the flag leaf is visible (except durum wheat and wampum varieties of spring wheat). For best results, apply at a rate of 0.2 to 0.4 ounce per acre.

For durum wheat and wampum varieties of spring wheat, Ally® Extra should be applied in combination with 2,4-D after the crop is tillering but before the boot stage of growth.
