

Pesticide Label Information

Listed below is information for pesticides that Grace Flying Service commonly applies. A copy of this document is on the website, along with more information on Worker Protection regulations. In some cases, when several off-patent products exist, we have listed the most common brand name.

Note that oral warnings and treated area posting is not required if no farm worker will be in the treated area during the REI or walk within ¼ mile of the treated area during the REI. Also, oral warnings and posting are not required for any worker who applied (or supervised the application of) the pesticide and who is therefore aware of the required information.

Also, there are exemptions for early entry for short-term tasks, limited contact, and emergency repairs, such as irrigation failures.
