

## Pesticide Label and REI Information Summary

Listed below is information for pesticides that Grace Flying Service commonly applies. In some cases, when several off-patent products exist, we have listed the most common brand names. Note that oral warnings and treated area posting is not required if no farm worker will be in the treated area during the REI or walk within ¼ mile of the treated area during the REI.

Also, there are exemptions for early entry for short-term tasks, limited contact, and emergency repairs, such as irrigation failures.
